

**Bill Perry Memorial Volunteer Scholarship

Application Process and Guidelines**

Bill Perry, along with his wife Anne, was a dedicated volunteer at Milford Regional Medical Center for nearly 20 years. Serving the Hospital in the mail room and coffee shop, Bill came into contact with many patients, family and staff members. He was beloved by all for his commitment to volunteerism, appreciation for education, passionate interest in sports and people, and wonderful sense of humor. An award of a \$500 scholarship will be made to one or more selected candidates.

To be eligible for this scholarship, candidates must have served at least 40 hours as a volunteer at Milford Regional Medical Center and demonstrate the qualities valued by Mr. Perry. Pursuit of a health related field, while not required, will be given preference.

Other extra curricular and/or community activities

A written essay of up to 1,000 words which shows the candidate's reflection of the interests of Bill Perry (*volunteerism, scholarship, humor, sports, connection with people*).

Process:

The selection committee will review all applications and essays and select finalists

Final candidates may be invited to be interviewed by the committee.

A check for \$500.00 will be given directly to the selected candidate(s).
