To be eligible for this scholarship the following criteria must be met:

- **Current or past Volunteer at Milford Regional Medical Center**
- **High School Senior with plans to attend College in the Fall**
- **Preference will be given to those pursuing a Health related career**

Extra Curricular and Community Activities
Financial Need**

Process:

- **Scholarship Committee will review all eligible entries and select final candidates.**
- **Final candidates may be invited to interview with the Scholarship committee. *Questions asked of the Final Candidates will relate to written essay.* A check in the amount of \$1000.00 will be made out and sent directly to the candidate(s) selected.**
